Presidents Letter - 2021 Annual Report

In 2021, we finally started our slow recovery from the COVID Pandemic. We still had many people absent for extended periods of time due to COVID, but we were able to maintain all operations.

Mission Services had a very difficult year due to all of the COVID restrictions that were still in place with the various Government and Private Agencies that we work with. But Mission was still able to accomplish quite a bit.

Overall, Mission Provided 32,619 Services to 16,150 Individuals. Thirty percent more than prior year. And forty-eight people were placed in competitive employment. Our Senior Program started the year with all twenty-two participants training from home - by December we had 11 training in person at agencies. Our VocHabs started the year limited to ten people (staff and participants). By the end of the year, we had all participants back to work. Twenty-six in Sandusky and 8 in Port Clinton. And we were able to resume our computer classes. Mission Services did a great job despite all of the obstacles that the COVID Pandemic caused

Retail had a strong year. Revenue of \$6,301,423 was 5.6% higher than 2019 (the last full year prior to COVID). The retail team was able to overcome significant staffing shortages and still achieved this excellent result.

Contracts revenue of \$3,375,210 was 14.6% higher than 2019. Also, despite staffing shortages, especially at the Fremont Plant. And Fremont started a major new literature program with Whirlpool, Tulsa, Oklahoma.

I want to especially thank all of our partners for their assistance in 2021. This includes donors, shoppers, contracts customers, and the many agencies that we work with in our Mission Programs. With your support we were able to accomplish a lot in 2021.

Goodwill is well known for it's secondhand stores and the fantastic finds that you get there, but if the retail team is the nerve system, then the heart and soul of Goodwill is it's Mission Services team. Last year the team, led by Director of Mission Services Marlis Rock, provided 32,669 services to 16,185 people.

The team developed and coached 48 people in 2021, 23 of whom worked directly for Goodwill and 25 of whom worked at other employers like Maurice at Don Tester.

Goodwill itself is accredited by CARF, the Commission on Accredidation of Rehabilitation Facilities.

Retail Services

2021 was another record-breaking year for Goodwill of Erie, Huron, Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, Inc. The Retail division had record revenues this year.

"2020 was a big challenge with Covid hitting so hard, but our stores bounced back in 2021 and set a record of \$6,301,423.00. That revenue was generated by the almost 400,000 customers (about half the population of Delaware) who came through our doors," said Jason Stout, Vice President, and CFO (Chief Financial Officer)

The retail division's round-up program, which contributes to our overall mission, also saw a record year with \$63,079.88 contributed to the program from 124,388 donors. An average of fifty-one cents.

The Secret Shopper program yielded some of the best results we have ever had, with the stores averaging 91% overall on the front end and 93% at the donor door
